Conversational Style Deborah Tannen 2005-07-21 This revised edition of Deborah Tannen's first discourse analysis book, *Conversational Style*--first published in 1984--presents an approach to analyzing conversation that later became the hallmark and foundation of her extensive body of work in discourse analysis, including the monograph *Talking Voices*, as well as her well-known popular books *You Just Don't Understand*, *That's Not What I Meant!*, and *Talking from 9 to 5*, among others.
