Bonzo, the pup, shows his stuff in *Boodgie Woodgie* when Tinker takes him busking and the Law butts in. The next tale, *Alfie*, has Tinker acting as advocate for an old sinner while a demon prosecutes and Death sits in judgement. Lastly, in *Time Passages*, a trip to the past discovers Tinker confronting his younger self and Jean, the ill-fated love of his life. A choice to make and a life at stake. Sadder, wiser hopefully, Tinker faces the future—perhaps in *Tinker Tales Two*? Regular readers of *Back Street Heroes* magazine may have seen some of these stories before, some of the characters may even seem vaguely familiar. Actually, there is a fair bit of reality in the mix, fact frequently being no stranger to fiction. Resemblance to anyone living, dead, or ethereal is but coincidental. Anyone offended by Tinker, or any other character, should remember they're the stuff of which dreams are made, and who can claim to control a dream?
