We learn how gay men meet their friends, what they typically do and talk about, and how these strong relationships contain the roots of larger cultural forces such as social movements and gay identities and neighborhoods. Nardi also points out the political and social consequences when friendships fail to provide support against oppression. I still have dreams about the military and about not finishing . . . It was my choice, but it wasn't really my choice" Aging and the Future "I think financing, of course, is a real big problem for lesbian women" "I have a concern that if anything should happen to my partner—in growing older—of being isolated from the gay community" . . . and much more! *Lives of Lesbian Elders: Looking Back, Looking Forward* also includes appendices that present demographic data on the women who were interviewed for the book, information on historical timelines, and suggested readings on lesbian history.
