

Responding To Physical And Sexual Abuse In Women With Alcohol And Other Drugs

An Exploratory Study of the Association Between Intimate Partner Male-to-female Violence, Mental Health Problems and Substance Use Among Victimized Women

Marika Guggisberg 2010 [Truncated abstract] This thesis is a report on an exploratory study that investigated the contribution of different forms of male violence against female intimate partners to mental health problems (anxiety, depression and PTSD) and to the use of psychoactive substances (alcohol consumption, cigarette smoking, non-medical use of pharmaceuticals, and illicit drug use) among a sample of adult community women in Perth, Western Australia. Little is known about the interaction of these phenomena. Therefore, the aim of this study was to explore the nature and scope of co-occurring mental health problems and/or alcohol and other drug use associated with women's victimisation in the context of an intimate relationship. The method used to answer the research question was quantitative with a questionnaire constructed specifically for the purpose of this study. Responses from 227 adult women in the metropolitan area of Perth, recruited from eight district offices of a government support service and a women's health service, provided information on recent exposure to male violence against intimate female partners; mental health problems and substance use using a self-completion, anonymous 96-item questionnaire. Descriptive statistics, Chi-Square analyses, cross-tabulations and logistic regression were conducted to investigate these associations and the influence of different Victim Types (Victim Type 1 women experiencing sexual, and physical violence along with controlling behaviour; Victim Type 2 women not experiencing sexual violence but physical violence and controlling behaviour; Victim Type 3 women not experiencing sexual or physical violence, but controlling behaviour; and Victim Type 4 women not experiencing any form of male violence as the reference group). A principal finding of this study was that women targeted by non-physical forms of male violence (Victim Type 3) suffered mental health problems and/or AOD use issues to a lesser extent than those participants experiencing physical and/or sexual violence with verbal abuse and/or controlling behaviour (Victim Type 1 and Victim Type 2). Furthermore, physical forms of male violence against female partners in general, but sexual violence (forced or demanded sexual intercourse) in particular, were statistically significant predictors of several forms of mental health and substance use problems, with the exception of pharmaceuticals use for non-medical purposes. Women with Victim Type 1 experienced substantially higher prevalence of multiple forms of mental health problems and multiple forms of substance use (homotypic comorbidity) as well as co-occurring mental health problems and alcohol or other drug use (heterotypic comorbidity) compared to women with violence victimisation not involving sexual violence. In fact, sexual violence victimisation predicted women's use of alcohol and other substances more than any other form of male violence against female intimate partners...

Sarah Michal Greathouse 2015 "Sexual assault continues to be a pervasive problem, both for society in general and within the military community. To assist the Air Force in its continued efforts to combat sexual assault within its ranks, we reviewed the existing empirical literature on the characteristics and behaviors of adult perpetrators who commit sexual assault against other adults. Our search was not limited to studies of military populations. While a vast majority of the existing literature has focused on sole male perpetrators who assault female victims, we identified some research on other types of perpetrators, including female sexual assault perpetrators, men who perpetrate assault against other men, and perpetrators who participate in group sexual assault. This body of research indicates that adult perpetrators are diverse in terms of their demographics, background characteristics, and motivations. Moreover, research indicates that sexual assault perpetration is likely influenced by a combination of factors, including an individual's developmental and family history; his or her personality, including attitudes/cognitions; and environmental factors, including peer attitudes and alcohol consumption. The complexity of factors that influence sexual assault perpetration and the multiple pathways that lead to an attack make it difficult to predict whether an individual is prone to commit sexual assault. While predicting sexual assault perpetration is problematic, we identified a number of factors related to perpetration that may be relevant for intervention efforts and offer recommendations for the Air Force"--Publisher's web site.
