Although studies have shown that approximately one in four women in the United States will experience rape in their lifetime, research on abuse, including sexual assault, has found prevalence rates to be much higher in the disabled community, including among Deaf women (Anderston & Leigh, 2011; Botta & Pingree, 1997; Kvam, 2004; Littleton et al., 2009; Smith, 2008; Ullman, 1996). Beyond prevalence, research on coping and recovery, strategies can improve legal and support resources for survivors of sexual assault. One such factor that can strongly influence recovery is disclosure, or the telling of the experience of rape to a person or agency. Using a sexual assault survey supplemented with a disclosure questionnaire, this study examined the following questions: 1. What is the rate of disclosure in a national sample of Deaf female survivors and how does assault type and acknowledgement of rape affect the rate of disclosure in Deaf female survivors? 2. What percentage of disclosures endorsed by Deaf female survivors will be considered helpful or unhelpful? 3. What personal, environmental, and socio-cultural factors related to disclosure (those found in the hearing population and those unique to the Deaf community) contribute to the experience being perceived as helpful or unhelpful for deaf female survivors? Results showed that disclosure was not as prevalent as expected but that, when participants did disclose, they found this coping strategy overwhelmingly helpful. Blame was the only significant predictor of disclosure helpfulness found in this sample. Specifically, being blamed predicted unhelpful disclosure; being told the assault was not the survivor's fault predicted more helpful disclosure. This suggests that disclosure, particularly if met with acceptance and lack of blame, can help deaf women heal after sexual assault." - Abstract.
