Sex in China Fang Fu Ruan 2013-11-22 China today is sexually (and in many other ways) a very repressive society, yet ancient China was very different. Some of the earliest surviving literature of China is devoted to discussions of sexual topics, and the sexual implications of the Yin and Yang theories common in ancient China continue to influence Tantric and esoteric sexual practices today far distant from their Chinese origins. In recent years, a number of books have been written exploring the history of sexual practices and ideas in China, but most have ended the discussion with

ancient China and have not continued up to the present time. A physician and medical historian, Dr. Ruan's doctoral dissertation was a study of the history of sex in China.

From the 1950s to 1980s, research on chigo was hindered by widespread homophobic prejudice. More recently, aversion to the age gap in historical master-acolyte relations has prevented scholars from analyzing the religious and political messages underlying the genre. Schmidt-Hori’s work calls for a shift in the hermeneutic strategies applied to chigo and chigo monogatari and puts forth both a nuanced historicization of social constructs such as gender, sexuality, age, and agency, and a mode

of reading propelled by curiosity and introspection.

sovereignty made by impotent emperors in a succession of short-lived dynasties. Erudite and immensely entertaining, this study of intellectual conceptions of sex and sexuality in China will be welcomed by students and scholars of early China and by those with an interest in the comparative development of ancient cultures.

Comrade Loves of the Samurai Ihara Saikaku 2011-06-07 In *Comrade Loves of a Samurai*, the theme of homosexual love between the samurai is explored. To the old Japanese such love among samurai was quite permissible.
