**Darwinian Feminism and Early Science Fiction** - Patrick B Sharp 2018-03-28

*Darwinian Feminism in Early Science Fiction* provides the first detailed scholarly examination of women’s SF in the early magazine period before the Second World War. Much like the Information Age of the twenty-first century, the Industrial Age was a period of great social changes brought about by rapid industrialization and urbanization, speed of travel, and global communications.
