Of Lovely Tyrants and Invisible Women Emma Domínguez-Rué 2011 This book examines images of female illness and invalidism as a metaphor of women's position of invisibility in Victorian and fin-de-siècle America, which pervade the fiction of the Virginia writer Ellen Glasgow (Richmond, 1873-1945). The study contends that the author explores the Victorian cult of invalidism to reveal the mechanisms of patriarchy: her novels warn against adhering to its values, since women are moulded to become epitomes of extreme delicacy and selflessness, being ultimately reduced to virtual inexistence.
