Thus, national level of gender research and particularly economic research and gender budgeting plays the key role in increasing gender equality, as national institutional specifics, history and culture, stereotypes, attitude towards women and women's rights, laws and infrastructure form unique combinations of gender inequality factors and possible paths of women empowerment. This paper aims to eliminate the key factors and consequences of gender inequality in Russia, basing on international and national statistics and indexes. According to Global Gender Gap Index Russia and other CIS (Eastern Europe and Central Asia) countries hold second place among emerging economies after Latin America and the Caribbean, lacking less than 1 p.p. However, more detailed look at the subindexes reveal that Russian actually holds very high positions in three of them. In Economic Participation and Opportunity Eastern Europe and Central Asia holds second place after North America, leaving behind Western Europe due to high level of female labor force participation rate, particularly at among professional and technical workers, where Russia holds the first place in the world, and legislators, senior officials and managers (21 place), but on the other hands gender income gap remains huge (87 place). Educational attainment and Health and Survival subindexes also have Russia holding first place due to measuring educational attainment, sex ratio at birth and life expectancy rather than gender discrimination within educational systems and health level of women and men. The last subindex -Political empowerment, - is the one that holds Russia behind Latin America and most other regions and countries (133 place out of 156) as women play very little part in government. What is even more disturbing is that the level of female participation in state government decreases. Why Russian institutions show such a contradictory level of gender inequality: wide economic opportunities and active economic participation sides with one of the lowest level of political empowerment of women? Present research suggests the institutional analysis if gender inequality in Russia within 6 axial institutions which are family and labor market, education and science, state and corporate governance.

**Isolating a Culture of Son Preference Among Armenian, Georgian, and Azeri Parents in Soviet-era Russia** Matthias Schief 2023 This paper analyzes historical census data from the final Soviet census in 1989. We find that, even in the absence of sex-selective abortions, the fertility decisions of Armenian, Georgian, and Azeri parents living in Russia in the late 1970s and the 1980s were significantly more son-biased than those of other ethnic groups in Russia. This finding suggests that the observed increase in the sex ratio at birth in the Caucasus since the end of the Soviet Union at least partially reflects a deep-rooted cultural preference for sons. Moreover, this result supports one of the key hypotheses of gene-culture coevolution, namely the claim that cultural evolutionary processes can shape selection on the basic components of genetic fitness.
