If one wanted to avoid writing Latina/Latino, one could simply write Latin@. In Germany, a research group from the Humboldt-Universität in Berlin developed the terms Professx and Studentx to avoid gendering the words Professor/Professorin and Student/Studentin. The letter x plays the role of a wild card here - similar to the @-sign in Spanish. The professor that led the research group had a personal interest in this: they do not identify as either female or male. This is still something that is considered ‘abnormal’ in most societies. Over the years, many things have improved for people that were once, or still are, not considered ‘normal’. Many minority groups can now enjoy more privileges that white, heterosexual, and cisgender people have always had. Legal rights have changed a lot over the last years. For example, it is now possible for trans\* people to legally change their gender/sex. Their situation is not perfect yet but it is improving, at least.
