Good Practice in Promoting Recovery and Healing for Abused Adults Jacki Pritchard 2013-02-28 What constitutes real recovery for adult victims of abuse? Current support offered to adults is often poorly planned and informed; this book sheds light on the true impact of abuse and how it can be healed. *Good Practice in Promoting Recovery and Healing for Abused Adults* explores the idea of 'recovery' being something physical in the short-term and 'healing' as an emotional process for long-term work. The issues covered range from child sexual abuse, domestic abuse and sex trafficking to the abuse of men and holocaust victims. With pedagogical features throughout, the book is essential reading for social workers, nurses, housing officers, support workers, counsellors, therapists, and for anyone working with adults who have experienced abuse in childhood or adulthood.
