Domestic Human Trafficking, Pimping, and Prostitution Enforcement in San Diego

Katherine Ann Morgan 2012 This research aimed to understand the scope, dynamics, and characteristics of domestic human sex trafficking in San Diego County. The methodology included a content analysis of 17 pimping case investigations, 12 face-to-face interviews with experts in the field, and an examination of the county's current policy and programming responses to these issues. The results of this study are limited due the small sample and lack of direct contact with pimps or prostitutes. This study found that the extent of pimping in San Diego County is greater than previous research indicated. Respondents who work in the field also noted that the rate of gang-related pimping appears to have significantly increased over the past five years and rival gangs are believed to share information and resources to maximize profits resulting from the sexual exploitation of young women. Additionally, major gaps in victim services were noted, such as lack of beds in safe houses, minimal 24- hour emergency services, and scant availability of programs tailored to juveniles and victims with children.

Sex Trafficking Samantha D. Wilson 2012 Sex trafficking is an issue that occurs both internationally and domestically, and it is one of the largest criminal industries in the world. On an international level, sex trafficking has received an immense amount of political and social awareness in the past decade; on the other hand, domestic sex trafficking remains out of the spotlight, thus, victim acknowledgement and identification has been minimal. The purpose of this thesis was to study the prevalence of domestic sex trafficking in the US. Specific goals were created to expose the truth behind the "pimp" and the "john", uncover the reasons that local agencies have not taken a more dominant role in identifying victims, and lastly, reveal how this all translates to the minimal

community resources offered and available to victims. The study was a comprehensive review of literature surrounding the issue, including the policy implemented to address domestic sex trafficking, risk factors of potential victims, and the cycle that a victim will endure throughout the lifestyle. The results of the study concluded that the glorification of pimps, the unaddressed danger of the johns, and the lack of local specialized task forces to handle these sensitive cases, all contribute to victim criminalization and ultimately, minimal aftercare services for victims.

KM Vs Human Trafficking 2017 Technology has dramatically changed the way criminals conduct their illicit activities. Specifically, the Internet has become a major facilitator of online human sex trafficking. Traffickers are using these technologies to market their victims which presents new challenges for efforts to combat sex trafficking. This study used knowledge management principles and natural language processing methods to develop an improved ontology of online sex trafficking advertisements. The language of these advertisements is constantly evolving; therefore, this study explored the role of a new type of indicator, emoticons, to the ontology of human trafficking indicators. Online classified advertisements from three major southern California cities/counties; San Diego, Los Angeles, and Orange County; were retrieved from Backpage.com as the dataset. Six known trafficking indicator categories, their associated keyword counterparts, and this data were used for the development of a new ontology of emoji indicators. The findings from this study indicate that emoticons have become the primary representation of four known trafficking indicators in advertisements, sale of services, underage victim, transient activity, and restricted movement. The key emoji indicators of trafficking for these categories are the rose, rosette, cherry, cherry blossom, growing heart, airplane, and crown emoticons. Alternatively, keywords are still the primary representation of ethnicity and county of origin in advertisements. Adoption of these emoji indicators for these categories is most prevalent for potential victims with East / South Asia origins and Hispanic/Asian/African American racial backgrounds. Additionally, the use of multiple emoji indicators links to a higher likelihood of the use of country of origin and ethnicity emoji indicators. Application of the model to the Backpage.com dataset indicated that four emoji indicators, four keyword indicators, or five indicators using the combined keyword/emoji ontology must be used in an advertisement to warrant a potential investigation. The proposed ontology provides a framework for the development of an automated knowledge management systems for filtering through the noise in online classified sites to identify potential cases of human sex trafficking. This KMS tool provides law enforcement with actionable intelligence in support of their counter human trafficking efforts.

Estimating the Prevalence of Human Trafficking in the United States: Considerations and Complexities National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine 2020-03-27 Human trafficking has many names and can take many forms - pimp control, commercial sex, exploitation, forced labor, modern slavery, child labor, and several others - and the definitions vary greatly across countries and cultures, as well as among researchers. In the United States, the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA) is the cornerstone of counter-trafficking efforts. It provides guidance for identifying and defining human trafficking, and it authorizes legislation and appropriations for subsequent counter-trafficking measures both within and outside of the federal government. First enacted in 2000, the TVPA has since been reauthorized by three administrations, and it includes a directive for the President to establish an Interagency Task Force to Monitor and Combat Trafficking. The subsequent Frederick Douglass Trafficking Victims Prevention and Protection Reauthorization Act of 2018 also includes provisions for victim services and plans to enhance collaboration efforts to fight trafficking abroad. To explore current and innovative sampling methods, technological approaches, and analytical strategies for estimating the prevalence of sex and labor trafficking in vulnerable populations, a 2-day public workshop, Approaches to Estimating the Prevalence of Human Trafficking in the United States, was held in Washington, D.C. in April 2019. The workshop brought together statisticians, survey methodologists, researchers, public

The Donna Gentile Story Anita Defrancesco 2021-02-28 When Donna Marie Gentile, escaped from a

home for delinquent girls and made her way to San Diego she had big dreams. She worked in security for a while and even dreamed of joining the police department. But things didn't work out as she planned. Donna, like many other innocent runaways, became a victim of the street walker life. While in survivor mode she was groomed, exploited, and coerced into prostitution, a path that took control of her life and ultimately led to her death at the age of twenty-two. Donna Gentile allowed herself to be befriended by several police officers thinking that this would afford her some protection in her dangerous life on the streets. Instead she was harassed and ultimately victimized by some of the same police to whom she had turned for help. But Donna was a fighter. Rather than taking the abuse, which included sexual harassment, she reported it to the San Diego Police Department. She testified against two officers, one of whom lost his job on account of her testimony. Her life became further complicated when the Internal Affairs Division exploited and coerced her into becoming a police corruption informant. Donna was scared. She left a voice recording with her attorney beginning with the words, "In case I disappear," and going on to state that "someone wearing a badge may turn out to be a serious criminal." In March 1985 while she was serving a sentence in Las Colinas jail the Philadelphia native wrote "My life is in danger when I get out." Then three months later her brutally murdered body was found on Mt. Laguna in the rural part of San Diego county. Gravel was stuffed in her mouth, something the mob does when it wants to warn others against being a "snitch." Donna's autopsy was sealed - the first and only autopsy ever to be sealed in the city of San Diego. Someone wanted to silence Donna. But who? "The Donna Gentile Story," written by Donna's first cousin lets you decide, and it gives voice to future runaways forced to survive on the streets as sex workers. It shows how Donna Gentile was a trailblazer who carved a path for women by not remaining silent in the face of harassment and abuse. In this way she was an early pioneer of the "Me Too" movement which, at long last, is telling women that not only can they speak out, but that they can also act. This high profile story exploded in the media and was nationally televised. Artists unveiled a billboard with the logo NHI, "No Humans Involved," bearing Donna's picture and facing toward the SDPD headquarters. We believe her murder was a "cover-up," perhaps of police incompetence, or perhaps of something much more sinister. The police try to label all sex workers as criminals. In fact many young women are victims of sex trafficking who have been coerced into prostitution, and sometimes the police are complicit in this.

To address this question, the study objectives are: (1) to evaluate the association between human trafficking and communicable diseases as a global health security threat, (2) to analyze and document the current challenges that the San Diego-Tijuana region faces due to inadequate binational efforts to combat this illicit but lucrative business, and (3) to support the need for binational cooperation, research, and information sharing in the San Diego/Tijuana regions regarding human trafficking prevention. Published books, journals, reliable news reports, and government documents were reviewed. San Diego/Tijuana health data from government sources were analyzed, and census data provided regional demographic trends. The findings demonstrate that the San Diego/Tijuana, BC, Mexico border is not only a hub of human trafficking, but also a hub of communicable disease because of human (sex) trafficking. The research also suggests that more in-depth epidemiological studies need to be performed in the marginalized, trafficked communities of persons in Tijuana, BC. Moreover, there is a lack of awareness and communication sharing among organizations working on human trafficking prevention and control. The conclusions add knowledge to current research linking anti-trafficking measures with global health efforts to stop the spread of communicable disease and improve global health security. These results call for additional binational academic, private, and governmental research on intervention and cooperation in order to implement programs to effectively respond to human trafficking in the San Diego/Tijuana border communities.

I knew these young men personally. They were not pimps and definitely not "traffickers," a new word to me that I had never heard before until now. A word that I had to learn the meaning of fast. How did I know that they weren't "traffickers"? I quickly found out that for many years of my life I myself was a trafficker. I sat in the courtroom silent, not able to speak my first-hand knowledge of "the game." Regardless of whether I knew my mentees were innocent or not, these were charges they could never shake. I listened as law enforcement experts testified from their expertise. Ha! What did they know? These were people who had never spent a single day in the subculture of pimping and prostitution. They had no clue what that life was really like and if they did they were lying on purpose to continue the mass incarceration of young black and brown lives. Yeah, that had to be it. Entering the anti human sex trafficking movement as a former pimp and trafficker, I knew I would be alone. My past will not be taken well by many, but what other option do I have, stay quiet? Should I not educate people about domestic human sex trafficking and the pimping culture I was raised to believe was my only way of success? I can't stay quiet! I can't go off and live a normal life, glad to have survived the game. Out of 8 of my closest friends I am one of 4 still alive. The only way to help end this cycle of death and incarceration is to teach the truth from my perspective. All sides of this problem must be at the table because so far only a portion of the story is being told. This portion of the story still doesn't truly reflect the lived realities of the many women survivors that I know and love. Staying quiet is not an option for me - I'm willing to die to save future generations from this trap. This was no "game" we were playing. It was an illusion. An illusion that was pressed upon me and my entire peer group as we grew up in
