The current research builds on the limited previous research and examines the perceptions of those women who are on the Florida Sex Offender Registry. A mail-out survey was sent to every eligible female sex offender residing in Florida as of March, 2010. Questions were asked testing strain, reintegrative shaming and defiance theories. The proposed hypotheses predict that the longer a female sex offender remains on the registry, levels of strain will increase, the amount of shame felt will increase and levels of defiance felt will also increase.
