*Homosexuality and the European Court of Human Rights* is the first book-length study of the Court's jurisprudence in respect of sexual orientation. It offers a socio-legal analysis of the substantial number of decisions and judgments of the Strasbourg organs on the wide range of

complaints brought by gay men and lesbians under the European Convention on Human Rights.
