Sexual Reckonings - Susan K. Cahn 2009-07-01

Sexual Reckonings is the fascinating tale of adolescent girls coming of age in the South during the most explosive decades for the region. A Not So Foreign Affair - Andrea Slane 2001-05-22

In *A Not So Foreign Affair* Andrea Slane investigates the influence of images of Nazism on debates about sexuality that are central to contemporary American political rhetoric. By analyzing an array of films, journalism, scholarly theories, melodrama, video, and propaganda literature, Slane describes a common rhetoric that emerged during the 1930s and 1940s as a means of distinguishing "democratic sexuality" from that ascribed to Nazi Germany. Finally, she applies her analysis of wartime narratives to contemporary texts, examining anti-abortion, anti-gay, and anti-federal rhetoric, as well as the psychic life of skinheads, censorship debates, and the contemporary fascination with incest.
