To help women recognize and combat this prejudice, Poullain advocated a modern, enlightened feminine education in *On the Education of Ladies*. Finally, since his contemporaries largely ignored Poullain's writings, he offered a rebuttal to his own arguments in *On the Excellence of Men*—a rebuttal that he promptly countered, strengthening his original positions. A truly modern feminist, Poullain laid the intellectual groundwork for the women's liberation movement centuries before it happened.
