Lydia's Open Door - Patty Kelly 2023-04-28

In this groundbreaking ethnographic study, Patty Kelly examines the lives of the women who work in the Zona Galactica, a state-run brothel in Chiapas's capital city. By delving into lives that would otherwise go unremarked, Kelly documents the modernization of the sex industry during the neoliberal era in the city of Tuxtla Gutiérrez and illustrates how state-regulated sex became part of a broader effort by government officials to bring modernity to Chiapas, one of Mexico's poorest and most conflicted states. Kelly's innovative approach locates prostitution in a political-economic context by treating it as work. Most valuably, she conveys her analysis through vivid portraits of the lives of the sex workers themselves and shows how the women involved are neither victims nor heroines.

Sex and the Sexual during People's Leisure and Tourism Experiences - Neil Carr 2010-05-11

Dead Girl Working - Cat McAuliffe 2017-02-15

The Disturbing True Crime Stories of Nine Serial Killers Who Murdered Sex Workers
Robert Hansen: An award-winning big game hunter who stalked Alaska's frozen tundra in the 1970s and 1980s, taking the lives of elk, sheep, wolves, and at least seventeen women. Arthur Shawcross: After raping and murdering two young children in New York, he was sent to prison, but he was paroled after serving fifteen years of his twenty-five year sentence. As a free man, he prowled the streets of Rochester's seedy red-light district, picking up drug-addicted prostitutes, choking the life out of their bodies, and discarding their corpses near the Genesee River. Johann Unterweger: At the age of twenty-four, this Austrian native committed his first murder, beating and strangling a young woman to death, and he received a life sentence for his crime. While incarcerated, he wrote plays, poems, short stories, and an autobiography, earning him the support of influential literary figures, intellectuals, politicians, and scholars who helped get him freed from prison after serving fifteen years. Within a year of his release, he murdered seven prostitutes in Europe, and while working in Los Angeles as a journalist, he killed three sex workers over the course of just a few weeks. Peter Sutcliffe: Over the course of five years, the Yorkshire Ripper terrorized the English county of West Yorkshire, murdering thirteen victims and leaving seven others near death with severe physical and emotional damage. He attacked women ranging in age from sixteen to forty-seven, using a variety of methods that included crushing their skulls with a hammer, strangling them with his hands, and viciously slashing their bodies with a knife or screwdriver, inflicting as many as fifty stab wounds on a single victim. Gary Ridgway: Known as the Green River Killer because of the body of water where he dumped some of his earliest confirmed victims, he methodically murdered at least forty-nine women, many of them teenage prostitutes who were as young as fifteen years old. Thanks to advancements in DNA, Gary Ridgway, who had long been a prime suspect in the killings that spanned sixteen years, was finally apprehended in 2001. Joel Rifkin: An outsider in his own life, he had difficulty forging connections with other people, so he regularly left his family's suburban home on Long Island to search the streets of New York City for prostitutes who could alleviate his crushing sense of loneliness. However, he soon discovered the drug-addicted women he picked up for

sex and companionship only cared about getting money or narcotics, leading him to take the lives of at least seventeen victims over the course of four years. Keith Jesperson: Known as the Happy Face Killer because he signed anonymous murder confessions with a smiley face, he was a long-haul truck driver who traversed the U.S., picking up prostitutes and drifters in one part of the country and dumping their corpses in another. The trucker went to great lengths to conceal the identities of the people he killed, even strapping the body of a victim to the bottom of his vehicle and driving at high speeds to grind off her skin. Volker Eckert: He got away with his first murder when he strangled a girl days before his fifteenth birthday, staging the crime scene to convince German authorities that the young woman had taken her own life. At the age of forty, he became a long-haul truck driver, which enabled him to crisscross Europe, picking up a foreign-born sex worker in one location and discarding her body in a different country. Steven Wright: Dubbed the Suffolk Strangler and the Ipswich Ripper by the British press, this English serial killer ruthlessly murdered five young woman over the course of just six weeks, posing some of their nude corpses in the shape of a crucifix.

Whitechapel Noise - Vivi Lachs 2018-05-14

Archive material from the London Yiddish press, songbooks, and satirical writing offers a window into an untold cultural life of the Yiddish East End. *Whitechapel Noise: Jewish Immigrant Life in Yiddish Song and Verse, London 1884-1914* by Vivi Lachs positions London's Yiddish popular culture in historical perspective within Anglo-Jewish history, English socialist aesthetics, and music-hall culture, and shows its relationship to the transnational Yiddish-speaking world. Layers of cultural references in the Yiddish texts are closely analyzed and quoted to draw out the complex yet intimate histories they contain, offering new perspectives on Anglo-Jewish historiography in three main areas: politics, sex, and religion. The acculturation of Jewish immigrants to English life is an important part of the development of their social culture, as well as to the history of London. In part one of the book, Lachs presents an overview of daily immigrant life in London, its relationship to the Anglo-Jewish establishment, and the development of a popular Yiddish theatre and press, establishing a context from which these popular came. The author then analyzes the poems and songs, revealing the hidden social histories of the people writing and performing them. For example, how Morris Winchevsky's London poetry shows various attempts to engage the Jewish immigrant worker in specific London activism and political debate. Lachs explores themes of marriage, relationships, and sexual exploitation appear regularly in music-hall songs, alluding to the changing nature of sexual roles in the immigrant London community influenced by the cultural mores of their new location. On the theme of religion, Lachs examines how ideas from Jewish texts and practice were used and manipulated by the socialist poets to advance ideas about class, equality, and revolution, and satirical writings offer glimpses into how the practice of religion and growing secularization was changing immigrants' daily lives in the encounter with modernity. The detailed and nuanced analysis found in *Whitechapel Noise* offers a new reading of Anglo-Jewish, London, and immigrant history. It is a must-read for Jewish and Anglo-Jewish historians and those interested in Yiddish, London, and migration studies.

Selling Sex - Emily Van der Meulen 2013

Cosmopolitan Sex Workers - Christine B.N. Chin 2013-04-15

Cosmopolitan Sex Workers is a groundbreaking look into the phenomenon of non-trafficked women who migrate from one global city to another to perform paid sexual labor in Southeast Asia. Through a new, innovative framework, Christine B.N. Chin shows that as neoliberal economic restructuring processes create pathways connecting major cities throughout the world, competition and collaboration between cities creates new avenues for the movement of people, services and goods. Loosely organized networks of migrant labor grow in tandem with professional-managerial classes, and sex workers migrate to different parts of cities, depending on the location of the clientele to which they cater. But while global cities create economic opportunities for migrants (and depend on the labor they provide), states react with new forms of securitization and surveillance. As a result, migrants must negotiate between appropriating and subverting the ideas that inform global economic restructuring. Chin argues that migration allows women to develop intercultural skills that help them to make these negotiations. *Cosmopolitan Sex Workers* is innovative not only in its focus on non-trafficked women, but in its analysis of the complex relationship between global economic processes and migration for sex work. Through fascinating interviews with sex workers in Kuala Lumpur, Chin shows that sex work can provide women with the means of earning income for families, for education, and even for their own businesses. It also allows women the means to travel the world - a form of cosmopolitanism "from below."

We join young people on their journeys to find premarital romance and witness their strategic and savvy risk taking when participating in transgressive aspects of consumer culture. The book reveals how social changes in India, including greater education and employment opportunities, as well as powerful middle class Muslim reform discourses, are impacting youth the very local level. More than just fantasy we see that Bollywood is an important role model which young people consult. By carefully negotiating risks and performing multiple identities inspired by modernity, globalization and, most of all, Bollywood culture, young people actively participate in a changing India and disrupt dominant discourses about slum youth as poor victims who are excluded from social change.

London as Screen Gateway - Elizabeth Evans 2023-07-26

London as Screen Gateway explores how London features within screen narratives and as a location of screen industry activity. Reflecting the diversity of roles the city plays both on screen and within the screen industries, the volume explores the intersection between London as a material place and its position within a cultural imaginary.

Conceptualising London as an archival city, as a collection of specific places and spaces, and as a part of national and international cultural and economic flows, contributors from film studies, television studies and media studies approach London through the lenses of textual analysis, historical work, industry studies and user experience. Street Sex Workers' Discourse - Jill McCracken 2013-04-17

Incorporating the voices and insights of street sex workers through personal interviews, this monograph argues that the material conditions of many street workers — the physical environments they live in and their effects on the workers' bodies, identities, and spirits — are represented, reproduced, and entrenched in the language surrounding their work. As an ethnographic case study of a local system that can be extrapolated to other subcultures and the construction of identities, this book disrupts some of the more prevalent academic and lay understandings about street prostitution by providing a thorough analysis of the material conditions surrounding street work and their connection to discourse. McCracken offers an explanation of how constructions can be made differently in order to achieve representations that are generated by the marginalized populations themselves, while placing responsibility for this marginalization on the society in which these people live.

Deviance - Leon Anderson 2017-08-22

"This sociology of deviance textbook draws on up-to-date scholarship across a spectrum of deviance categories, providing a symbolic interactionist analysis of the deviance process. The book addresses positivistic theories of deviant behavior within a more encompassing description of the deviance process that includes the work of deviance claims-makers, rule-breakers, and social control agents. Cross-cultural and historical treatment of deviance categories provides background for understanding current conceptions of, and responses to, deviance. The book is divided into four parts. Chapters in Section Three addresses various forms of lifestyle deviance, including alcohol abuse, drug abuse, and sex work. Negotiating Sex Work - Carisa R. Showden 2014-04-01

Globally, discussions about sex work focus on exploitation. The media regularly provides us with stories about teen girls coerced to perform sexual acts for money, frequently beaten and robbed by their pimps or traffickers. While one would have to be hard-pressed to deny that sex workers are victimized, the popular media and our political leaders

emphasize sex work as exclusively exploitative. In *Negotiating Sex Work*, Carisa R. Showden and Samantha Majic present a series of essays that depict sex work as an issue far more complex than generally perceived. Positions on sex work are primarily divided between those who consider that selling sexual acts is legitimate work and those who consider it a form of exploitation. Prostitution and Sex Work - Melissa Hope Ditmore 2010-12-16

A fascinating overview of prostitution and sex work in the United States, from the Colonial era to today, examines the issue as it affects men, women, and transgender individuals of all races and classes. *Prostitution and Sex Work* is the first book since 1921 to offer a historic overview of this controversial topic—and what our views on it say about American society. Legalized Prostitution in Germany - Annegret Staiger 2022-02

Germany has been infamously dubbed the "Brothel of Europe," but how does legalized prostitution actually work? Is it empowering or victimizing, realistic or dangerous? In *Legalized Prostitution in Germany*, Annegret D. Staiger's ethnography engages historical, cultural, and legal contexts to reframe the brothel as a place of longing and belonging, of affective entanglements between unlikely partners, and of new beginnings across borders, while also acknowledging the increasingly exploitative labor practices. By sharing the stories of sex workers,

clients, and managers within the larger legal system—meant to provide dignity and safety through regulation—Staiger skillfully frames the economic aspects of commercial sex work and addresses important questions about sexual labor, intimacy, and relationships. Weaving insightful scholarship with beautiful storytelling, *Legalized Prostitution in Germany* provides readers with a deeper understanding of the complexities of legalized prostitution.

Street Corner Secrets - Svati P Shah 2014-07-29

Street Corner Secrets challenges widespread notions of sex work in India by examining solicitation in three spaces within the city of Mumbai that are seldom placed within the same analytic frame—brothels, streets, and public day-wage labor markets (nakas), where sexual commerce may be solicited discretely alongside other income-generating activities. Focusing on women who migrated to Mumbai from rural, economically underdeveloped areas within India, Svati P. Shah argues that selling sexual services is one of a number of ways women working as laborers may earn a living, demonstrating that sex work, like day labor, is a part of India's vast informal economy. Here, various means of earning—legitimized or stigmatized, legal or illegal—overlap or exist in close proximity to one another, shaping a narrow field of livelihood options that women navigate daily. In the course of this rich ethnography, Shah discusses policing practices, migrants' access to housing and water, the idea of public space, critiques of states and citizenship, and the discursive location of violence within debates on sexual commerce. Throughout, the book analyzes the epistemology of prostitution, and the silences and secrets that constitute the discourse of sexual commerce on Mumbai's streets.

Historical Sex Work - Kristen R. Fellows 2020-10-13

This volume explores the sex trade in America from 1850 to 1920 through the perspectives of archaeologists and historians, expanding the geographic and thematic scope of research on the subject. *Historical Sex Work* builds on the work of previous studies in helping create an inclusive and nuanced view of social relations in United States history. Many of these essays focus on lesser-known cities and tell the stories of people often excluded from history, including African American madams Ida Dorsey and Melvina Massey and the children of prostitutes. Contributors discuss how sex workers navigated spatial and legal landscapes, examining evidence such as the location of Hooker's Division in Washington, D.C., and court records of prostitution-related crimes in Fargo, North Dakota. Broadening the discussion to include the roles of men in sex work, contributors write about the proprietor Tom Savage, the ways prostitution connected with ideas of masculinity, and alternative reasons men may have visited brothels, such as for treatment of venereal disease and impotence. Focusing on the benefits of interdisciplinary collaboration and including rarely investigated topics such as race, motherhood, and men, this volume deepens our understanding of the experiences of practitioners and consumers of the sex trade and shows how intersectionality affected the agency of many involved in the nation's historical vice districts.
