Consistent with its title, that work focused on specific health issues identified by communities, researchers, and AIDS service providers that were and continue to be of concern. During the preparation of that volume, I received numerous telephone calls and e-mails from women in various parts of the country, asking why a book was not also being developed to address their often-neglected concerns. Accordingly, the topics addressed in *Identities and Sexualities of Minority Women* were developed based on input from minority women who participated in focus groups conducted in diverse regions of the United States. These focus groups were held specifically to provide an opportunity for sexual minority women in minority communities to identify those issues that from their perspective are most salient and relevant to their lives. It is not surprising, in view of the variation in process by which the topics were identified, as well as the differences in perspective associated with differences in sex and gender, that this resulting compilation of topics departs substantially from the focus of the companion text addressing health issues of minority men who have sex with men.
