excerpted from plays but don't include any background information, this annotated guide tells you what you really need to know about audition material from more than 300 contemporary plays. Here is how the book works. Suppose that you're looking for a dramatic male/female scene. When you scan "Part One: Play Synopses and Analyses," you come across an entry for *The Middle of the Night* by Paddy Chayefsky. If the material seems appropriate, all you have to do is

get a copy of the play and get to work. Because *The Ultimate Scene and Monologue Sourcebook* enables you to make informed decisions about the suitability of more than 1,000 monologues and scenes—which you can find easily through the book's extensive cross indexes—you'll gain a critical edge in the auditioning process.
