[I Never Gave My Consent](#) Holly Archer 2016-07-28 In 2013, a series of high-profile court cases sent shockwaves through the West Midlands town of Telford. Seven men, all from the town's Pakistani heritage community, were jailed for selling vulnerable young girls for sex. The convictions made national news, but for one girl the chilling headlines were all too real. Holly Archer was just fourteen when her life changed forever after becoming embroiled in a frightening web of exploitation and abuse. Enduring countless violent rapes and death threats, she was forced to sleep with several men a night. As her abusers' grip tightened, she fell into despair, twice becoming pregnant. Holly slowly began to pick up the pieces of her life and was given a job with a rape prevention charity. Having survived her ordeal, she now tells her full, shocking story for the first time. *I Never Gave My Consent* is a courageous yet uplifting memoir of someone who faced the cruelest of circumstances. Human Trafficking in Ohio Jeremy M. Wilson 2007 Human trafficking has garnered a significant and growing amount of attention from the U.S. government since the 1990s, culminating in the passage of the federal Trafficking Victims Protection Act in 2000. There is also a growing body of research on human trafficking, but most of it has focused on trying to show that human trafficking is a problem. Wilson and Dalton explore the extent and characteristics of concrete cases of human trafficking in Columbus and Toledo, Ohio, as well as the awareness of and response to the problem by the justice systems and social service provider communities in the two cities. The authors summarize their content analysis of newspaper accounts as well as key respondent interviews that they conducted with criminal justice officials and social service providers in each site. These identified several cases of juvenile sex trafficking and forced prostitution in Toledo, as well as a smaller trafficking market centered on the forced labor of noncitizens in Columbus. Wilson and Dalton compare the two cities' considerably different responses to human trafficking, and conclude with suggestions on how to raise awareness about human trafficking and improve the responses of the criminal justice system, the juvenile justice system, and social services to the problem.

Sex Trafficking in Nonurban Environments Daniel Manolesco 2023 This research investigates sex trafficking in Pennsylvania with a specific focus on Blair County. It presents what sex trafficking is, the different stages of sex trafficking, the different types of sex trafficking, the actors involved in sex trafficking, facilitating factors of sex trafficking, social media use in sex trafficking, and sex trafficking in nonurban environments. It addresses the following questions: (1) what factors contribute to Blair County having a higher rate of sex trafficking when compared to other counties of the fifth class; and (2) what role did social media play in the cases of sex trafficking in Blair County. The project consisted of a case study of a sex trafficking ring in Blair County. The results demonstrate how the group operated and avoided law enforcement for as long as it did. The

conclusion is that: the cooperation of trafficked individuals and witnesses is crucial for prosecuting sex traffickers, the treatment of trafficked individuals as criminals inhibits their cooperation, and that current drug laws potentially inhibit the cooperation of trafficked individuals and witnesses. This project was originally focused on sex trafficking in Northeastern Pennsylvania. However, as is a common theme in combating sex trafficking, there was not enough data available. This led to the project focusing on sex trafficking in nonurban environments.

Often the customers-- mostly Americans and Europeans--paid \$56/minute for the girls to perform live sexual acts (web-cam sex) based on the customers’ typed requests transmitted via computers (de Leon 2013). In the case of the three girls, who were eight years old when the abuse started, U.S. agencies, the Philippine National Police and the non-profit Visayan Forum Foundation received tips on one of their frequent customers, Jeffrey Herschell from Washington, Pennsylvania with the help of the victims. This information helped law enforcement arrest and sentence the offender to 12 years in federal prison (Coorlim 2013).
