A literature review was conducted including current pertinent research articles, fiction and non-fiction books, poetry, and popular music to position this study with the present literature as it relates to the experience of losing at love. There were implied suggestions about the stages of grief resolution, coping mechanisms, sex differences in stress responses, and the relationship of current losses to childhood experience via Bowlby's attachment theory. Heuristic methodology for obtaining data was employed in this study. Data was obtained by open-ended narrative interviews. The tape recorded interviews were then transcribed, themes were pulled from the transcriptions, and both edited and verbatim data were used to illustrate these themes. Identifying affect, behavior, and cognitions of the experience were also pulled from the transcripts and presented. Two especially descriptive narratives were added to portray some

of the depth of the experience. A creative synthesis was written to capture the essence and spirit of the experience of losing at love. The data was summarized, and implications and applications were discussed with regard to personal and therapeutic development.
