The Sex Offender Housing Dilemma Monica Williams 2018-05-08 The controversy surrounding community responses to housing for sexually violent predators When a South Carolina couple killed a registered sex offender and his wife after they moved into their neighborhood in 2013, the story exposed an extreme and relatively rare instance of violence against sex offenders. While media accounts would have us believe that vigilantes across the country lie in wait for predators who move into their neighborhoods, responses to sex offenders more often involve collective campaigns that direct outrage toward political and criminal justice systems. No community wants a sex offender in its midst, but instead of vigilantism, Monica Williams argues, citizens often leverage moral, political, and/or legal authority to keep these offenders out of local neighborhoods. Her book, the culmination of four years of research, 70 in-depth interviews, participant observations, and studies of numerous media sources, reveals the origins and characteristics of community responses to sexually violent predators (SVP) in the U.S. Specifically, *The Sex Offender Housing Dilemma* examines the placement process for released SVPs in California and the communities' responses to those placements. Taking the reader into the center of these related issues, Monica Williams provokes

debate on the role of communities in the execution of criminal justice policies, while also addressing the responsibility of government institutions to both groups of citizens. Hosprisoners Katherine Elizabeth Rosoff 2012 The current study focused on the experiences of California's Sexually Violent Predators (SVPs), convicted sex offenders who have been indefinitely committed to a state hospital after having served a prison sentence. A content analysis was performed using a collection of newsletters and a book published by California's SVPs between 2000 and 2011. The newsletters were viewed through the lens of theories about risk, governance, and control, as well as theories regarding labeling and societal reaction. The newsletters were used to construct a narrative counter to current representations or understandings of sex offenders by the public, the media, and politicians. In order to construct this narrative, they focus on several issues the detainees find to be most important: the illegitimacy of the mental health professionals, the complicity that comes with complying with the treatment regimen, and the illegitimacy of the labels applied to them.

Sex Fiends, Perverts, and Pedophiles Chrysanthi S. Leon 2011 From MeganOCOs Law to JessicaOCOs Law, almost every state in the nation has passed some law to punish sex offenders. This popular tough-on-crime legislation is often written after highly-publicized cases have made the gruesome rounds through the media, and usually features harsh sentences, lifetime GPS monitoring, a dramatic expansion of the civil commitment procedures, and severe restrictions on where released sex offenders may live. Does Internet Information on Sex Offenders Reduce the Rate of Sex Offenses? Michael Angelo Roussis 2010 In September 2004, California passed an amendment that expanded the breadth of the State's version of Megan's Law, the general name for any statute mandating that sex offenders register with the local community after being released from incarceration. This amendment, Assembly Bill 488, created a website under the California Department of Justice so that citizens could search for sex offenders in any community. After the passage of California Assembly Bill 488 in 2004, the number of sex crimes in California dropped nearly 10% from 9,750 to 8,800. I estimate the differential impact that this amendment had on deterring sex crimes by past criminals and new criminals. Using multivariate analyses on all arrests in California from 2001 to 2008, the estimated odds of any arrest being a sex offense are 15.7% lower after the passage of California Assembly Bill 488 compared to before enactment of the law. The odds that any arrest for a new offender will be a sex offense are 7.1% lower compared to before enactment of the amendment. In contrast, the odds that any arrest for a past offender will be a sex offense are 18.7% lower compared to before the law. Therefore, Assembly Bill 488 deterred sex crimes, but with a stronger effect on those offenders with any criminal history than someone without a prior record. This result indicates that California's amendment increasing public access to sex offender information over the Internet has had a deterrent effect on past arrestees. While this is an encouraging effect, the legislature must continue to keep pace with advances in web technology to deter crime.
