There is a review at the end of each session to ensure the SAs have understood the key points before they progress to subsequent sessions.

Crime and Punishment Fyodor Dostoyevsky 2022-08-23 Fyodor Dostoevsky's *Crime and Punishment* focuses on the mental anguish and moral dilemmas of Rodion Raskolnikov, an impoverished ex-student living in Saint Petersburg who feels compelled to rob and murder Alyona Ivanovna, an elderly pawn broker and money lender. As usual in Dostoyevsky's work, he brilliantly explores the psychology of his characters for a deeper understanding of their motivation and conflict central to the human condition.
