Sex, Gender, and Christian Ethics - Lisa Sowle Cahill 1996-08-28

This book endorses feminist critiques of gender, yet upholds the insight of traditional Christianity that sex, commitment and parenthood are fulfilling human relations. Their unity is a positive ideal, though not an absolute norm. Women and men should enjoy equal personal respect and social power. In reply to feminist critics of oppressive gender and sex norms and to communitarian proponents of Christian morality, Cahill argues that effective intercultural criticism of injustice requires a modest defence of moral objectivity. She thus adopts a critical realism as its moral foundation, drawing on Aristotle and Aquinas. Moral judgment should be based on reasonable, practical, prudent and cross-culturally nuanced reflection on human experience. This is combined with a New Testament model of community, centred on solidarity, compassion and inclusion of the economically or socially marginalised.

Conditionally Accepted - Baker A. Rogers 2019-12-13

This book explores Mississippi Christians' beliefs about homosexuality and gay and lesbian civil rights and whether having a gay or lesbian friend or family member influences those beliefs. Beliefs about homosexuality and gay and lesbian rights vary widely based on religious affiliation. Despite having gay or lesbian friends or family members, evangelical Protestants believe homosexuality is sinful and oppose gay and lesbian rights. Mainline Protestants are largely supportive of gay and lesbian rights and become more supportive after getting to know gay and lesbian people. Catholics describe a greater degree of uncertainty and a conditional acceptance of gay and lesbian rights; clear differences between conservative and liberal Catholics are evident. Overall, conservative Christians, both evangelical Protestants and conservative Catholics, hold a religious identity that overshadows their relationships with gay and lesbian friends or family. Conservative religion acts as a deterrent to the positive benefits of relationships with gay and lesbian people.

Rick Ormrod - Reviewing a book that focuses on Biblical languages, specifically the Old Testament might strike those who know me as an odd thing for me to be doing, but the subjects of sex ad sexuality are pertinent ones in the church at the present time and several Old testament verses are used as "clobber texts" by those who support the traditional views, so receiving a copy of this book was timely in many ways. I approach this book as somebody who has zero knowledge of the original languages the Biblical books were written in and who hasn't really wanted to learn, having struggled in the past with modern languages and content to benefit from the knowledge of others through the use of commentaries. The book opens with an engaging introduction and a strong authorial voice that immediately draws the reader into the writer's enthusiasm for his subject, a blog post that has grown and become an interesting and well

researched piece of academic writing that is nevertheless accessible to any reader with a good understanding of the Hebrew Scriptures. The introduction states that "you shouldn't need to know or learn and Hebrew in order to read and understand this book" and this is indeed the case. Throughout there is sufficient translation and explanation of the subtleties of the translation of different Hebrew words and phrases that I feel I fully understood the points made at various points without knowledge of the original language. I think the book really succeeds for me on two fronts. It demonstrates quite clearly that the church's traditional understanding of certain passages and verses is not supported by the Hebrew and that some opinions have been based on some possibly very inaccurate translation. The book also reinforces the value of listening to the voices of those who can bring the latest understanding of translation from the Biblical languages into English and of being open to God bringing us greater understanding and knowledge through those he has given this particular gift to.
