Gender Role Personalities and Physical Attractiveness Laura F. Bailly 2012 The purpose of the current study was to explore whether personality dispositions can influence perceived physical appearance. Past research demonstrates that gendered and non-gendered characteristics lead to differential preferences for potential romantic interests among males and females (e.g., Cash & Smith, 1982). These previous studies have not, however, measured direct influence on pulchritude. In the present study, gendered and non-gendered personality descriptions were paired with pictures of average-looking individuals of both sexes to determine the influence of gender roles on perceived physical attractiveness. I hypothesized that males would find androgynous females more physically attractive than gender-typed and non-gender typed females. Similarly, females would find androgynous males more physically attractive than gender-typed and non-gender typed males. Findings indicated that feminine and androgynous personalities significantly increased perceived physical attractiveness of target females for the male participants, whereas undifferentiated and masculine roles significantly decreased perceived physical attractiveness of target males for female participants. Target photographs accompanied by feminine personality descriptions were rated the highest in overall desirability by both sexes.

The Negative Side to Physical Attractiveness Amy Lauren Spicer 2008 ABSTRACT: While much research that has investigated the topic of physical appearance has primarily looked at the advantages physically attractive people receive, there has been a lack of research focused on the possible disadvantages from being physically attractive. Although there has been numerous studies that have found support for physically attractive people to have more socially desirable traits, obtain more prestigious careers, to be more likely to be helped in emergency settings, and to receive lighter criminal sentences than unattractive people, there also has been studies that have found a negative aspect to being physically attractive such as being seen as more vain, snobbish, and 'women in a stereotypical male occupation perceived as being incompetent. This project sought to further explore the disadvantages physically attractive individuals may receive. The project was designed as to have participants rate their emotional reactions and trait perceptions of a female target

with the target being depicted in one of three different occupations: less prestigious position (receptionist), more prestigious position (manager), and a neutral position (college professor). The project had two hypotheses which expected to find that when the target dressed in a sexy manner in a stereotypical male occupation there would be more negative perceptions about her competence compared to the target dressed in a neutral manner and female raters would be more negative in their reactions and perceptions to the target dressed in a sexy manner. It was found that females rated both the professor and manager as being more incompetent and more irresponsible compared to the receptionist. Also it was found that females rated the sexy picture of the professor and manager as more efficient than the receptionist. While these findings add to the literature on the disadvantages of being physically attractive, they do not provide an absolute resolution to the issue.

The Social Psychology of Facial Appearance Ray Bull 2012-12-06 Several years ago Coleman (1981) reported that in 1979 one of the many international cosmetics companies had an annual sales figure of \$2.38 billion, nearly 1.25 million sales representatives, and over 700 products, the majority of these being for the face. Cash and Cash (1982) noted that in 1979 U. S. consumers spent over \$4 billion on cosmetic products. They stated that, "Although this practice would seem to be a fascinating aspect of human behavior on the basis of its generality and resilience, social-behavioral scientists have largely ignored the phenomenon so plainly (or pleasingly) in front of their eyes." Why should people be so concerned with their facial appearance? Many psychologists have argued (e.g., Kleck & Rubenstein, 1975) not only that facial information is usually the first that is available to the perceiver, but also that it is continuously available during social interaction. Maruyama and Miller (1981) stated that "appearance is often the first dimension upon which a stranger can be evaluated. Since people tend to see others as integrated and consistent units, rather than as collections of situation-specific behaviors, a potent and immediately evident basis for an evaluation, such as physical appearance, should intrude into and affect any overall and subsequent evaluation."
