build upon Ann duCille's *The Coupling Convention: Sex, Text and Tradition in Black Women's Fiction* in which she explores the romantic relationships of black characters and how the desire for and success of such relationships translated into political strivings for its writers. My work also builds upon Felipe Smith's *American Body Politics* and the discussion of the threat to national identity that black people were/are, but I change the focus of Smith's work from the biological black body (yet maintaining some attention to the body politic) to what that body represents. Smith claims that the black body comes to symbolize an inferiority, dysfunctionality, and backwardness in black people. Drawing on the discussions of Smith, and duCille, as well as the historical work on love by Karen Lystra and Karen Tracey, I expand these claims to illustrate how the discourse surrounding black bodies is collected and exploited in the images of black love relationships to discuss issues of national identity.

In the first book we will discuss these issues mainly as they pertain to the white male then in the second we move on to the black female, finishing off in the third by addressing black men and white women. In doing this we are trying to give a different perspective to each viewpoint held, to offer a different perspective on the subject. But not in some boring scholarly talk with stats and graphs or hifalutin words but in a very simple down to earth way with a fresh comedic and entertaining story, that weaves all the points and counterpoints throughout leaving you, the reader to come to your own conclusions at the end.
