The "A" team is materialistic, pays attention to matter and the senses, honors ancestors, and is motivated by eros while focusing on lover and children. "Team 1", on the other hand is anthropocentric, works with infinite integers that create equations and produce quotients. Team "1" is idealistic, pays attention to form, doesn't seem interested in ancestors and is motivated by agape while focusing on neighbors and pets. Trang concludes that both teams are valid and necessary, similar to Mary and Martha. As someone who loves listening to stories, she naturally falls in line with Team A but is grateful that Team 1 is there to do the accounting. Elizabeth Carroll Trang has a master's degree in religion and a bachelor's degree in Chinese language and literature. Her interests include the fourth commandment (honor your father and mother), filial piety, ancestors, desire, the sense of touch, intuition, and the Holy Eucharist. She argues that many a marriage is upheld as holy when the only thing "holy" about it is a piece of paper, and that thus people should, with careful consideration, allow for divorce under certain circumstances, in order to uphold the ideal of a true sacred and loving marriage. She devotes a chapter or so on the differences (and non-differences) between men and women, on marital rape, and on the harmful ignorance of young women about sex at the time of their wedding. Regardless on your opinions on sex before (and after) marriage, this book provides an interesting, progressive theological perspective on sex and marriage that deserves to be read and considered by everyone from conservative to liberal, and will be understood by Christians and non-Christians alike.
