Let every young woman aspire to high degrees of purity and excellence. Let her great aim be, to be personally holy-like God her Saviour. To this end and with this aim, let her be ready to set aside, if necessary, father and mother, and brother and sister-yes, and her own life also, -assured that if she does it with a sacred regard to God and duty, all will be well. Let her but follow Christ according to the gospel plan, if it lead her to prison and to death. But it will not thus lead her. For every self-denial or self-sacrifice it involves, she will secure, as a general rule, manifold more in this present life, and in the world to come, life everlasting.
