By successfully applying this perspective to social care practice, they facilitate the need for practitioners to reflect on personal aspects of ageing and care but also to bridge the gap between the personal and the professional.

**Creating Caring Connections** - Jennifer

Intergenerational art programs respond to the needs of contemporary age-segregated society by cultivating mutually beneficial interactions between generations. Through community-based programs, professionals in the field of art education can emphasize values of lifelong learning and understanding across age groups. This action-research study explored possibilities and challenges that exist within the emerging field of Creative Aging. Topics addressed are (a) results of diverse populations coming together in a social context for participatory art-making; (b) how I, as an artist and an educator, engaged participants in critical and meaningful dialogue; (c) the struggles, conflicts, and significant moments experienced in an intergenerational art program; and (d) how a Creative Aging program affected the personal, social, and societal realities of older adults and university students. I partnered with non-profit organizations on the North Side of Chicago to develop free arts

programming in two 5-week sessions. I investigated the intersection of art, social integration, and community development by engaging low-income older adults with service-learning students. Participants ranged in age from the late teens to late 80s, including more than 6 different ethnicities and cultures. My research responded to increasing social isolation of low-income older adults identified by local organizations. Workshops were designed to promote mutual intergenerational conversations through collaborative and individual art projects. Data was collected through interviews, student reflections, photographs, surveys, and field notes. Results enabled both older adults and university students to better understand themselves and to develop a more positive outlook towards aging through creative processes, increased interpersonal connections, and acknowledgement of diverse perspectives. With the exponential growth of older populations, it is imperative to help transform

social relationships between generations to encourage positive attitudes towards aging. Disregarding older populations, a symptom of cultural isolation, breaches universal human rights. An inclusive society values all stages of human development and sustains itself by encouraging the cultivation of creative intergenerational relationships and dialogue as a practice of restorative justice.
