The book includes in vivo and in vitro studies on prostatic carcinoma and concludes with a chapter on functional and structural changes in male accessory sex organs during aging. Their secretions decrease susceptibility to cold shock, provide energy to the spermatozoa, regulate the pH of the seminal plasma, and contribute to in vivo fertility. The development and function of these glands have been extensively examined in rodents as the primary model. Learning more about their development and morphogenesis can provide insight into prostatic neoplasias and better treatment and preventative care in humans. In agriculture, increased knowledge about the accessory glands and their secretions can improve fertility and storage of sperm used for artificial insemination. The purpose of this study was to determine if reduced levels of endogenous estrogen result in accelerated maturation of these accessory sex glands, specifically the secretory tissue in prepubertal boars. second objective was to evaluate potential differences in maturation of the prostate and seminal vesicles. These objectives were examined using immunohistochemical detection of smooth muscle alpha actin, FGF10, and Sox9 antibodies, potential maturity markers, in littermate boars treated with Letrozole or the canola oil vehicle. Image analysis was used to estimate changes in the proportion of stromal and secretory tissue. Results suggested differences in maturation of the prostate and seminal vesicles. Decreased endogenous estrogen appeared to initially accelerate maturity in the accessory sex glands. Expression of Sox9 appeared to decrease with increased maturation and the time of changes in label intensity in the seminal vesicles and prostate suggest different maturation profiles. Determining the relationship between estrogen and maturation of accessory sex glands will help understand maturation of these glands and the secretions they produce.

When STIEVE published his work on male reproductive organs in this handbook in 1930, a definitive treatment of the morphology of the accessory sex glands seemed accomplished. Nevertheless, the increasing bulk of scientific literature published in the last years on this topic has demonstrated that new methods, e. g. ,

developments in the fields of electron microscopy, cytochemistry and auto radiography, pose new questions. These principally morphological techniques have yielded new insights into the fine structure and functional organization of these glands. The stress, however, lay on biochemical questions concerning the mechanism of hormone action, since the accessory sex glands were considered to be primary target organs of hormone action, i. e. , their cells bind specific hormones. Besides the basic interest of endocrinologists, morphologists, and biochemists, several unanswered questions arose from the practitioners, e. g. , urologists, andrologists, and other clinicians, especially as regards the prostate gland, one of the organs most affected in elderly men. Thus, the epidemiologic investigations of the last years proved this very organ to be one of the most frequent causes of death in elderly men (HANSEN, 1977). The view of the practitioner established a special field of investigation and effected a shift from morphologic analysis to biochemical or endocrine aspects. Nevertheless, morphology, if tempered by experimental or concomitant biochemical studies, provides a solid base for tracing the pathologic events occurring in these organs.
