First, it is my opinion that the trials are an integral part of the individual's biographical story and of history; secondly, some readers of my past publications have asked for a book just about the trials of those best known to readers interested in English Tudor history. The trials included in this edition are accumulated from many sources. Only a very few have been left out because actual trial records were not found, only a conglomeration of notes from many sources that give the reader a basic account of the legal

proceeding. During the reign of Elizabeth I, record keeping and trial transcripts became more frequent and regular.
