Martyrdom, Mysticism and Dissent - Asghar Seyed-Gohrab 2021-08-23
This book is the first extensive research on the role of poetry during the Iranian Revolution (1979) and the Iran-Iraq War (1980-1988). How can poetry, especially peaceful medieval Sufi poems, be applied to exalt violence, to present death as martyrdom, and to process war traumas?
