**The Police Perspective on Sex Offender Orders** Katy Knock 2002 Sex Offender Orders (SOOs) serve to prohibit an offender from certain types of behaviour that have previously been a precursor to offending, and are intended to help prevent further serious offences before they are committed. The decision to apply for a SOO lies with the police. It can be used against anyone with a previous caution or conviction for an offence listed in Schedule 1 of the Sex Offenders Act 1997. A SOO is a civil order that requires the civil standard of proof, however, a breach constitutes a criminal offence, triable either way, and attracts a maximum penalty of five years imprisonment. This report provides an overview of the use of SOOs in England and Wales since their inception to 31 March 2001.

*Child Sexual Abuse* Julia Davidson 2008-05-07 Child Sexual Abuse critically evaluates the development of policy and legislative measures to control sex offenders. The last fifteen years has seen increasing concern on the part of the government, criminal justice agencies, the media and the public, regarding child sexual abuse. This concern has been prompted by a series of events including cases inviting media attention and involving the abduction, sexual abuse and murder of young children. The response to this wave of child sexual abuse revelation has been to introduce increasingly punitive legislation regarding the punishment and control of sex offenders (sex offenders are the only group of offenders in British legal history to have their own act), both in custody and in the community. But this response, it is argued here, has developed in a reactionary way to media and public anxiety regarding the punishment and control of sex offenders (who have abused children) and the perceived threat of such offenders in the community.

Individuals who Have Been Convicted of a Sex Offense Brenna L. Scott 2022 Sex offender legislation, both at the state and federal level, was designed to keep communities safer. However research suggests that many of these laws do not decrease recidivism and in some cases may increase risk for reoffending. Despite this there has been little movement to repeal these laws. As such, it is important to understand how the current legislation impacts individuals who have committed a sex offense and their ability to successfully reintegrate into communities post-incarceration and what if anything can be done to improve existing laws. The current study surveyed 46 individuals convicted of sex offenses about their opinions about current sex offender legislation and what they would do to improve it. Respondents consistently endorsed negative attitudes towards sex offender-specific legislation. When asked to consider future offenders' punishments, respondents overall endorsed more punitive legislation when the crime in question was committed against a child vs. an adult. Recommendations for improvement included a more 'case-by-case' lens when considering the sanctions a person should have to face, less punitive restrictions, and shorter-term sentencing. Findings are discussed as they pertain to future research and legislative reform.

Rehabilitating Criminal Sexual Psychopaths Nathaniel J. Pallone 2018-09-03 More than half the states in this country have legislation on sex offenders that distinguishes between those whose offense is incidental to other offenses ("felony" sexual offenders), and those who engage in "repetitive, habitual, or compulsive" sex offenses ("criminal sexual psychopaths"). This second category is the subject of this book. The legislation specifies that criminal sexual psychopaths must be treated, not punished. But treatment is problematic; the literature on various approaches finds uncertainty about the effectiveness of treatment. Pallone asks the difficult question of whether there is a prospective right to effective treatment, and notes the political and ethical questions involved in potentially more effective Clockwork Orange approaches. The ethical burden on mental health clinicians is heavy; despite the fact that the category "sexual psychopath" is essentially a legal, not a psychiatric category, judges tend to follow professional recommendations as to categorization. Pallone emerges with some surprising but convincing conclusions. If the distinction between felony and psychopathic sexual offender is essentially empty, as the profession feels it is, it should be abandoned. All criminal sexual offenders should be punished, except those who opt for treatment and who are certified by mental health professionals as likely to benefit. And for those few so identified, society should be prepared to commit significant resources to their treatment. This speculation on the past, present, and future of criminal sexual deviation comes from a psychologist with a broad command of the literature and deep professional experience in the area. Combining a broad-ranging overview of the legal, criminological, and psychiatric literature on these questions, *Rehabilitating Criminal Sexual Psychopaths* raises important questions. Legal experts, criminologists, mental health professionals, and all those concerned with public policy will find it significant.

Sexual Violence Elizabeth L. Jeglic 2016-10-24 The purpose of this edited volume is to examine the disconnect in the sexual violence prevention field between legislation, research and practice. *Public Perception in the Legislative Process* Haily Elizabeth Perkins 2021 Current sex offender legislation focuses on preventing subsequent sex offenses—providing a tool for law enforcement and the public to monitor convicted sex offenders. This scheme fails to account for the original victim and the potential for future known or related victims. Furthermore, it is inconsistent with empirical research regarding the recidivism of convicted sex offenders. This research has three specific goals—(1) analyze the descriptive details available for Washington state registered sex offenders (RSO; n=19,532), (2) assess the accuracy of public perception for Washington state residents regarding sex offender characteristics and legislation, and (3) assess the role or influence of public perception within the legislative drafting and enactment process. Question 1 utilizes the Washington State Sex Offender Registry (n=19,532). The analysis revealed that almost 40% of RSOs in Washington are Male, White, and between 36–59 years of age. Further, supplemental data regarding victim relation for RSOs (n=3,273) revealed that 90% perpetrated against a juvenile and 35% against a juvenile family member. Question 2 utilizes previously collected public perception data for Washington State residents (Fisher and Pedneault, 2017). Compared with the descriptive analysis from Question 1, public perception of Washington state residents was incorrect concerning the offender's age and risk for recidivism. Question 3 utilizes semi-structured interviews of Washington state legislators, and the resulting analysis utilizes the Grounded Theory of qualitative analysis in Atlas.ti. The interview respondents discussed their legislative function, providing different legislative experiences as anecdotal evidence. There are multiple entry points for public perception into the legislative process—the main two being direct constituent contact and legislative standing committee hearings. The complexity of public perception within the drafting and enactment process is exacerbated when legislating public safety issues due to the need to overcome fear and misperception.

*Violence, Sex Offenders, and Corrections* Rose Ricciardelli 2017-07-06 Sex offenders remain the most hated group of offenders, subject to a myriad of regulations and punishments beyond imprisonment, including sex offender registries, chemical and surgical castration, and global positioning electronic monitoring systems. While aspects of their experiences of imprisonment are documented, less is known about how sex offenders experience prison and community corrections spaces – and the implications of their status on their treatment and safety in such environments. *Violence, Sex Offenders, and Corrections* critically assesses what is meant by the term ‘sex offender’, and acknowledges that such meanings are socially constructed, situated, and contingent. Ricciardelli and Spencer use conceptions of gender and embodiment to analyze how sex offenders are constituted as objects of fear and disgust and as deserving subjects of abjection and violence.

**Internet Child Abuse: Current Research and Policy** Julia Davidson 2010-09-13 *Internet Child Abuse: Current Research and Policy* provides a timely overview of international policy, legislation and offender management and treatment practice in the area of Internet child abuse. Internet use has grown considerably over the last five years, and information technology now forms a core part of the formal education system in many countries. There is however, increasing evidence that the Internet is used by some adults to access children and young people in order to ‘groom’ them for the purposes of sexual abuse; as well as to produce and distribute indecent illegal images of children. This book presents and assesses the most recent and current research on internet child abuse, addressing: its nature, the behaviour and treatment of its perpetrators, international policy, legislation and protection, and policing. It will be required reading for an international audience of academics, researchers, policy-makers and criminal justice practitioners with interests in this area.

**Discretion Without Choice** Jonathan C. Varhola 2011 In a historically recent development, sex offenders have arguably become a focal point of attention in discourses surrounding sexuality, childhood, and crime. Much research has been accomplished regarding the treatment and recidivism of such offenders, as well as consequences of sex offender legislation and policy initiatives. However, little research has been done regarding specifically the discretion of criminal justice agency professionals involved in the day-to-day handling of these types of cases. This study focused on the effects of such policies on judicial discretion, as measured by sentencing outcomes. Data was collected from publicly available internet sexual offender registries and county court records in two adjoining Ohio counties. A multiple linear regression analysis was used to create a model that predicts 46% of the variance in correctional sentencing outcome. Results indicate that judicial discretion appears to exist, yet is informed heavily by the presence of a rape charge, chronological age gaps between offenders and victims, and whether a case ends in a trial or a plea agreement. This study concludes that the effect of sexual offender legislation and policy on judicial discretion is one of sufficient limitation.

**Impacts of Sex Crime Laws on the Female Partners of Convicted Offenders** Lisa Anne Zilney 2020-06-01 This work is an exploratory examination of the experiences, motivations, and coping mechanisms of women who are involved in intimate relationships with registered sexual offenders. The study focuses both on women who were involved with an offender prior to the commission of his offense and who stayed with him



post-conviction, and on women who became involved with a registered offender after his sex offense conviction. Like the offender himself, these women face a variety of challenges in responding to treatment of them by friends, family, the community, and the criminal justice system. Utilizing the results of intensive interviews, this work provides a unique look at the women who are one of the few sources of support for registered sexual offenders and assesses the effectiveness and wide-ranging implications of community notification and registration laws on public safety, policy, and practice. This work offers alternative approaches based on evidence and case studies and considers the significance of familial contact in buffering sexual recidivism. These women are the heretofore unstudied victims of sexual offending legislation. This book is essential reading for those in sociology, criminology, psychology, and social work. For undergraduate or graduate students, practitioners, researchers, or policy makers, this thought-provoking book will shed light on how to optimize the reintegration of sex offenders. *The Politics of Fear* Mary Katherine Huffman 2015 Existing sex offender management legislation generally represents an emotional response to a few well-publicized incidents involving child-victims. Federal and state legislative initiatives mandating sex offender registration for all defendants convicted of a sexually-oriented offense lack an empirical foundation and should be modified to embrace the scholarly research produced in the past twenty-five years. The abundant research focused on sex offenders, while persuasive, fails to consider the role of the judiciary in sex offender management. Sex offenders can be more effectively supervised by restoring a measure of judicial discretion to offender management.
