The answer proposed in this article is that the U.S. Constitution is a part of the problem. It is time to reconsider sex education in our public schools, and ask what it is exactly that we are trying to accomplish and if it is truly a comprehensive sexuality education that we are providing. I hope to provide my reader with an understanding of the pedagogical approach I observed in Waterville, Maine and what it means for the way teenagers in these public school systems understand their sexual bodies and what they can do with them. Having only studied three classrooms in depth, I cannot say with any certainty that my findings are fully generalizable. What I believe, however, is that if the construction of sexuality I witnessed in these central Maine classrooms has anything in common with the bulk of classrooms in the United States, then comprehensive sexuality education has a long way to go before it becomes truly comprehensive, or even, educational.
