We assessed gonadal hormones during the fasted state in drug-naive patients with psychosis. Fasting serum concentrations of follicular-stimulating hormone (FSH) and luteinizing hormone (LH), testosterone, free-testosterone, Sex Hormone Binding Globulin (SHBG) and estradiol (E2) were compared between a group of 55 newly diagnosed, drug-naive, first-episode men with psychosis and a group of 55 healthy controls, matched for age, smoking status and BMI. Testosterone and free-testosterone levels were significantly lower in the patients' group and SHBG levels significantly higher in the patients' group compared to those in healthy controls. Testosterone, free-testosterone and SHBG were compared between a group of 32 drug-naive, first-episode females with psychosis and a group of 32 healthy controls matched for age, smoking status and BMI. The groups had similar values in the hormones which were measured.

Sex Hormonal Profile During The Development From Endometrial Hyperplastic Disease To Endometrial Cancer Yue Shi 2017 Purpose To investigate the endocrine characteristics and abnormalities through the development from endometrial hyperplasia to endometrial cancer Patients and Methods A total of 1488 women were enrolled, including 768 healthy women, 103 patients were diagnosed with disordered proliferative endometrium (DPE), 206 with simple hyperplasia (SH), 158 with complex hyperplasia (CH), 131 with atypical endometrial hyperplasia (AEH), and 122 with endometrial carcinoma (EC) (G1, G2). Serum sex hormone panel including sex hormone binding globulin (SHBG), serum estradiol (E2), progesterone (P), testosterone (T), follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH), and luteinizing hormone (LH), fasting blood glucose (FBG), fasting serum insulin (FINS) and body mass index (BMI) were evaluated. Results Physiologically, text-book hormonal profiles were confirmed with our study in control group. Significant differences were found among different stages during disease progression for all endocrine factors except for testosterone. Further multivariate logistic regression test holding age constant noted estradiol elevation were observed only in pre-malignant stage, while progesterone decrement persisted from DPE to EC. Disease progression seemed only associated with total E2 level instead of the free form. BMI gradually increased and peaked at EEC, with both median and mean levels higher than 25kg/m². In multivariate analysis, obesity, SHBG and IR were shown to be most associated with the disease progression. Conclusion: Estrogen was observed to be consistently increased starting from DPE and peaked in the group of AEH while decreased sharply once the disease progressed into EC.
