go of it. At the root of this destruction, lies religion and its misuse, and the secrets spun to protect one's faith. Prior to foster homes, reform schools, biker gangs, petty crime, and her ultimate ten-year career as a nude dancer in Montreal clubs, a period during which she began to create her acclaimed *Melody* comics, this is where it all began.

It is one of the few disability memoirs to focus on activism, and one of the first by an immigrant.
