involved in personifying and transmitting the faith. Other constitutional and statutory provisions also safeguard religious

freedom, if not always perfectly. Catholic institutions could take far better advantage of all of these existing protections if they

communicated, first, how they differ from secular institutions: how their missions emerge from their faith in Jesus Christ, and

their efforts both to make his presence felt in the world today, and to display the inbreaking of the Kingdom of God. Second,

they need to draw out the link between their teachings on sexual responsibility and love of God and neighbor. Drawing upon
