The way you approach the subject will depend on your child's age. For a young child, be positive but truthful when you talk about the crush. Guide him or her in making appropriate decisions. For instance, if your daughter wants to give a gift to a boy she likes on Valentine's Day, help her choose something that won't be overwhelming for either party.
