Gego came into her own as a multidisciplinary practitioner in the midst of Venezuela's rapid development into a modern state. Born in Hamburg in 1912, she trained as an architect and engineer in Germany before fleeing Nazi persecution in 1939, when she immigrated to Venezuela. There Gego worked as an architect and a designer before embarking on an artistic career that she pursued over the course of four decades until her death, in 1994.
