It excites strong passions, which have provided the impetus for political movements. This is undoubtedly the case in great proportion due to the interest of many of the Christian religions, as well as the interest of many Jews, in abortion as a sinful act. The tone of much of the concern regarding abortion and the proper use of the genitals might in fact suggest to the uninformed that Christianity was more interested in sexual truancy than in feeding the poor, the Gospels notwithstanding. It was at this moment that the radical-Pietist Moravians of the first half of the eighteenth century reinvented themselves as a noncontroversial evangelical denomination.
