After qualitative analysis of the data was conducted, seven themes emerged: girls' closeness is due to proximity; talking is the process by which girls bond emotionally; friends are adolescent girls' strongest perceived support system; trust is the deep distinction between what a girl considers a "best" friend and a "close" friend; conflicts are resolved relatively easily between friends; there is often a competition between girls for the attention of boys or other female friends; and best friends have mutual admiration and respect for one another.
