frequent or daily headaches pose a very difficult problem for the physician who has to treat them, particularly as many patients think that there should be a medicine or medicines which give them instant relief. In the search for the compound which would meet this very natural desire, many drugs have been manufactured and the temptation for the physician is either to increase the dose of a drug which seems to be, at any rate, partially effective, or to add one or more drugs to those which the patient is already taking. Although there have been some references to the dangers of overdose of drugs for migraine in the past, it was not until relatively recently that it was recognized that drugs given for the relief of headache, if taken injudiciously, may themselves cause headache. The first drugs to be implicated in this way were ergotamine and phenazone. In the case of ergotamine tartrate, the dangers of ergotism were well known as this was a disorder which had been known and written about for many years. In the treatment of headache, fully blown ergotism is rare and in recent years has usually been due to self-medication in doses much greater than those prescribed although there are a few recorded cases where toxic amounts have been given.

The Role of Relevant Peptides on the Sex-specific Nature of Migraine Amanda Danielle Avona 2021 Migraine is considered to be both one of the most disabling and common disorders worldwide yet, migraine is both more common and disabling among women. While this disorder affects 2-3 times as many women as men across the globe the reasons for this disparity are not known. These data present new insights regarding how calcitonin gene-related peptide interacts with the predominantly female hormone prolactin to create female-specific hypersensitivity in rodent models of migraine. This sensitivity to dural CGRP is also contingent on the presence of ovarian secreted hormones, although it is not yet clear which are responsible for mediating this effect. While CGRP is likely in part responsible for the prevalence of migraine in women, in this dissertation we present

evidence that dural amylin leads to hypersensitivity in males, but not in females. As such amylin may mediate migraine in males; however, ovariectomized females demonstrate more robust responses to dural amylin, than their male counterparts. The data covered in this project may provide valuable information for the development of sex-specific migraine therapeutics.

Disentangling the Contribution of Gender Roles and Sex Hormones on Sex Differences in Chronic Pain Across Multiple Large Population Cohorts

Gianluca Guglietti 2022 "Intro: Women are significantly more likely to experience chronic pain than men. Despite the sex differences in chronic pain conditions, the etiology of these differences is not fully understood. Previous studies have attributed these disparities to the social dimension of pain across genders due to differences in psychosocial variables such as willingness to report pain, gender specific stressors, and gender roles. However, recent preclinical research has pointed toward possible biological factors for differences in pain. In the following research, we aim to disentangle the effect of gender and sex hormones across two large cohorts, the United Kingdom Biobank (UKBB) and Northern Finland Birth Cohort (NFBC). Methods: Data was obtained from the UKBB and NFBC where we have access to pain status, complete blood hormone levels (Testosterone and Sex Hormone Binding Globulin), and psychosocial data for a diverse population of over half a million individuals and six thousand individuals respectively. We investigated gender by developing a weighted gender index using logistic regression modelling. We selected gender related variables spanning the four aspects of

gender as defined by the women's health research network at the CIHR. These included socioeconomic status, domestic labour, sexual violence, and personality traits. These variables were entered in a logistic regression model to predict sex. The probability outputs of this model (the percent likelihood of a given individual to be a woman) were used as an individual gender index for each participant. The respective contributions of sex hormones and the gender index on chronic pain prevalence were explored using odds ratios after stratifying by sex and controlling for age. Results: We show consistent sex differences in chronic pain prevalence across body sites in both the UKBB and the NFBC, with women reporting greater rates of chronic pain across body sites particularly facial and headache pain.
