Sex Trafficking of Children in the United States - Congressional Research Service 2015-01-28

The trafficking of individuals within U.S borders is commonly referred to as domestic human trafficking, and it occurs in every state of the nation. One form of domestic human trafficking is sex trafficking. Research indicates that most victims of sex trafficking into and within the United States are women and children, and the victims include U.S. citizens and noncitizens alike. Recently, Congress has focused attention on domestic sex trafficking, including the prostitution of children, which is the focus of this report. Federal law does not define sex trafficking per se. However, the term "severe forms of trafficking in persons," as defined in the Victims of Trafficking and Violence Protection Act of 2000 (TVPA, P.L. 106-386) encompasses sex trafficking. "Severe forms of trafficking in persons" refers, in part, to "[s]ex trafficking in which a commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud, or coercion, or generally agree that the trafficking term applies to minors whether the child's actions were forced or appear to be voluntary. The exact number of child victims of sex trafficking in the United States is unknown because comprehensive research and scientific data are lacking. Sex trafficking of children appears to be fueled by a variety of environmental and situational variables ranging

from poverty or the use of prostitution by runaway and “thrown-away” children to provide for their subsistence needs to the recruitment of children by organized crime units for prostitution. The TVPA has been the primary vehicle authorizing services to victims of trafficking. Several agencies have programs or administer grants to other entities to provide specific services to trafficking victims. Despite language that authorizes services for citizen, lawful permanent resident, and noncitizen victims, appropriations for trafficking victims' services have primarily been used to serve noncitizen victims. U.S. citizen victims are also eligible for certain crime victim benefits and public benefit entitlement programs, though these services are not tailored to trafficking victims. Of note, specialized services and support for minor victims of sex trafficking are limited. Organizations specializing in support for these victims may have fewer beds than might be needed to serve all victims. Other facilities, such as runaway and homeless youth shelters and foster care homes, may not be able to adequately meet the needs of victims or keep them from pimps/traffickers and other abusers. In addition, it has been suggested that minor victims of sex trafficking—while too young to consent to sexual activity with adults—may at times be labeled as prostitutes or juvenile delinquents and treated as criminals rather than being identified and treated as trafficking victims. These children who are arrested may be placed in juvenile detention facilities instead of environments where they can receive needed social and protective services. Finally, experts widely agree that any efforts to reduce the prevalence of child sex trafficking—as well as other forms of trafficking—should address not only the supply, but also the demand. Congress may consider demand reduction strategies such as increasing public awareness and prevention as well as bolstering investigations and prosecutions of those who buy illegal commercial sex (“johns”). In addition, policy makers may deliberate enhancing services for victims of trafficking. The most recent reauthorization of the TVPA, in March 2013, reauthorized some existing provisions, created a new grant program to combat child sex trafficking, and authorized appropriations

through FY2017.

Estimating the Prevalence of Human Trafficking in the United States:

Considerations and Complexities - National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine 2020-02-27

Human trafficking has many names and can take many forms - pimp control, commercial sex, exploitation, forced labor, modern slavery, child labor, and several others - and the definitions vary greatly across countries and cultures, as well as among researchers. In the United States, the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA) is the cornerstone of counter-trafficking efforts. It provides guidance for identifying and defining human trafficking, and it authorizes legislation and appropriations for subsequent counter-trafficking measures both within and outside of the federal government. First enacted in 2000, the TVPA has since been reauthorized by three administrations, and it includes a directive for the President to establish an Interagency Task Force to Monitor and Combat Trafficking. The subsequent Frederick Douglass Trafficking Victims Prevention and Protection Reauthorization Act of 2018 also includes provisions for victim services and plans to enhance collaboration efforts to fight trafficking

abroad. To explore current and innovative sampling methods, technological approaches, and analytical strategies for estimating the prevalence of sex and labor trafficking in vulnerable populations, a 2-day public workshop, *Approaches to Estimating the Prevalence of Human Trafficking in the United States*, was held in Washington, D.C. in April 2019. The workshop brought together statisticians, survey methodologists, researchers, public health practitioners, and other experts who work closely with human trafficking data or with the survivors of trafficking. Participants addressed the current state of research on human trafficking, advancements in data collection, and gaps in the data. They discussed international practices and global trends in human trafficking prevalence estimation and considered ways in which collaborations across agencies and among the U.S. government and private-sector organizations have advanced counter-trafficking efforts. Every day in the United States, children and adolescents are victims of commercial sexual exploitation and sex trafficking. These are not only illegal activities, but also forms of violence and abuse that result in immediate and long-term physical, mental, and emotional harm to victims and survivors. In 2013, the Institute of Medicine/National Research Council released the report *Confronting Commercial Sexual Exploitation and Sex Trafficking of Minors in the United States*. The report found that the United States is in the very early stages of recognizing, understanding, and developing solutions for these crimes. SEX TRAFFICKING IN THE UNITED STATES - Carolina Hernandez 2014

Though human trafficking consists of many forms of exploitation, the sex industry comprises of the largest group of victims. While the topic of sex trafficking has received much attention internationally, this form of exploitation has recently gained attention in the United States. The United States is a transit nation to which sex trafficking victims are being brought to work. The United States is also being affected by the recruitment of victims into this underground market. Utilizing secondary data from the Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR), this current study explores sex trafficking in the United States, using interviews with sex trafficking victims. Analyses focused on the characteristics of this victim population, recruitment, consequences of involvement, and coping. Results demonstrate that the majority of women became involved in the sex industry at a relatively young age and had been recruited by someone they knew or someone who they believed loved them. These women came from physically and sexually abusive backgrounds which contributed to the control their traffickers were able to have over them once involved in the industry. As a result of their exploitation, women suffered from significant mental health issues. The stories of trafficking victims help shed light on the importance of highlighting the voice of the victim. Sex trafficking is defined as smuggling people, mostly women and children, across worldwide borders and forcing them to become involved

with prostitution, pornography, stripping, live-sex shows, mail-order bride services, military prostitution, and sex tourism (Zhang, 2007). It is prevalent both nationally and internationally, predominantly in third-world countries. According to the Trafficking in Persons Report of 2010, each year 12.3 million adults and children are trafficked worldwide and 40,000 to 50,000 of those are trafficked into the United States. Fifty-six percent of this population is women and children. Sex trafficking victims are women and children of different ages, socioeconomic statuses, and ethnicities from all over the world. Venkatraman (2003) suggested, "no neighborhood in the world is immune to human trafficking activity" (p. 2). Sex trafficking is one of the most profitable criminal activities, as traffickers make anywhere from \$13 to \$20 billion worldwide per year (Zakhari, 2005). New policies such as the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 (TVPA) and the William Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act of 2008 (TVPRA) have started to target human trafficking at the federal level. These policies increase criminalization fines, punishment for perpetrators, and provide sex trafficking victims with benefits and psychological services. Individual states in the United States have also passed laws to combat human trafficking. They have helped set a strong foundation and the precedent needed in fighting sex trafficking. However, because of globalization, a culture of tolerance of sex trafficking, a high demand for prostitution, and worldwide government corruption, sex trafficking continues to be a low-risk criminal activity. This study examined sex trafficking in the United States by looking at two different databases, the Department of Justice and the University of Michigan's Human Trafficking Law Project. It analyzed the number of suspected sex trafficking incidents, factors involved in the sex trafficking process, and the characteristics of the victims and perpetrators.
