Barras knows from personal experience the traps and the fury of being a black fatherless daughter, and she makes her own life story the heart and soul of her book, alternating chapters of spellbinding memoir with the stories she has gathered from women all over the country. Passionate and shockingly frank, *Whatever Happened to Daddy's Little Girl* is the first book to explore the plight of America's fatherless daughters from the unique perspective of the African-American community.
